

PLAYER CODE OF CONDUCT

Players must conduct themselves at all times in a manner which does credit to GSA. This includes:

Sportsmanlike conduct
Courtesy
Respect for teammates, coaches, referees, and opponents

As part of the team, each player must make a commitment to reach for team goals by always doing their best and having a good attitude toward what is in the best interests of the team. This includes giving 100% at an assigned position.

In addition, GSA has implemented the following specific rules of player conduct:

1. Follow directions of the coaches.
2. Do not miss practices or games.
3. Always support other teammates.
4. Show good sportsmanship.
5. Keep a strong desire to play soccer.
6. Try hard to be the best player you can be.
7. Practice at home.
8. Keep yourself physically fit and eat nutritionally.
9. Be ready to start practice and games on time.
10. Bring proper equipment to each practice and game (ball, shoes, shin guards, sockes, clean uniforms [for games only, no practice], and water bottle).
11. Treat teammates, coaches, and referees with respect.
12. NO foul language or gestures.
13. Use and/or possession of drugs, alcohol, and/or tobacco by minors is strictly forbidden.

Player's conduct that does not conform to these rules may cause loss of playing time or dismissal from the program with forfeiture of all fees paid.
